Shay 13T Class A (1:20.3 scale)



The 13-2 Class A straight boiler Shay locomotive was one of Lima's industrial success stories. Despite its small stature, the design was built for a wide variety of gauges. Today there is only one known survivor of this design of 13-2 Class A, as built for Queensland, Australia in 1908 and 1914. In 1948, the two much worn Shays were rebuilt into one viable locomotive to become known simply as 'Shay'. Shay was retired in 1960 and is now preserved at the Nambour Museum in Qld.

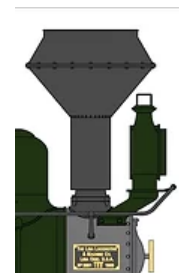
